Pray this set of verses anytime you feel less confident or when you need a little courage:

For you have been my hope, O Sovereign LORD, my confidence since my youth. I have no fear of sudden disaster or of the ruin that overtakes the wicked, for the LORD will be my confidence and will keep my foot from being snared. In him and through faith in him I may approach God with freedom and confidence. I am confident of this, that he who began a good work in me will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus, I will approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that I may receive mercy and find grace to help me in my time of need. This is the confidence I have in approaching God: that if I ask anything according to his will, he hears me. And if I know that he hears me— whatever I ask—I know that I have what I asked of him. I am confident of better things—things that accompany salvation. Therefore, brothers, since I have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way opened for me through the curtain, that is, his body, and since I have a great priest over the house of God, I will draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having my heart sprinkled to cleanse me from a guilty conscience. . . .
